

### RESOLUTION NO. 2017-15

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT CHANGING THE NAME OF FOX AVENUE TO LOTUS POND COMMON

WHEREAS, Purple Lotus Temple has submitted a formal application to change the name of Fox Avenue to Lotus Pond Common to symbolize the positive values that the temple represents; and

WHEREAS, Fox Avenue is located in the Centerville Community Plan Area off Alvarado Niles Boulevard, is designated on the City General Plan as a minor local street, measures approximately 4,473 feet long, and serves 25 addresses; and

WHEREAS, the Geographic Information Systems Division in accordance with the Community Development and Fire Departments is responsible for naming new streets and assigning street numbers within the city and has no objections to the renaming of Fox Avenue to Lotus Pond Common; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission considered this item at its March 23, 2017 meeting and has recommended that the City Council change the name of Fox Avenue to Lotus Pond Common; and

WHEREAS, Purple Lotus Temple will pay for all labor and material costs attributed to this project for new street signs and poles; and,

WHEREAS, renaming Fox Avenue to Lotus Pond Common is consistent with and furthers the General Plan goal to maintain a connection between the community and everyday life.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The renaming of Fox Avenue to Lotus Pond Common is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301, existing facilities, as it involves no expansion or change to the use of the street.

SECTION 2. The application to change the name of Fox Avenue to Lotus Pond Common is approved and staff is directed to reflect this change on all relevant maps and resource documents maintained by the City.
