## Dear Mr. Centeno:

At your request, a new address is being issued to reflect the new orientation of your home from Mission Boulevard to Vivian Place. The enclosed map indicates the **newly assigned** street address number for your project. Please update your address records and outside address numbers as soon as possible for the purpose of rapid identification of your property, in the case of an emergency. Any occupants and property owner of this parcel should review and update their records that are registered with the City (such as for building permit and/or business tax purposes).

From the authority of the Fremont Municipal Code, Section 7-5109, Ordinance 89: *Display of Numbers – Notice to Owners*.

The department designated to establish, continue, operate and maintain the numbering system shall give notice to the occupants or owners of land or buildings which are assigned or reassigned numbers under the system, which notice shall contain the old number, the new number or number reassigned to a particular building or parcel of land, and the date on which the new number shall become effective.

Additionally, from Section 7-5110, Ordinance 89, as amended by Ordinance 113: *Same – Numbers Must be Displayed Within Ten Days of Notice*.

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Within ten days of the effective date of the notice of number assigned or reassigned, the occupants or owners of the property or buildings shall cause the number to be displayed upon the building and shall remove or obscure from public view any old or previous number not in accordance with the system.

By copy of this letter, we are notifying the below-listed agencies and utility companies of this change. Some agencies may not update their records until notified by the property owner. Therefore, it is your responsibility to contact the agencies directly to assure the address change has occurred.
